

Attaching photos of children's work to Google Classroom

There are 2 ways of doing this: [using Google classroom app](#) on your phone or [taking a photo separately and then uploading using a laptop](#).

Using Google classroom app

Parents can install the Google classroom app on their phones. This is easier as photos can be taken of work within the app and uploaded straightaway.

Install Classroom to your mobile device

Android

To use Classroom on your Android device, download the Classroom app from Google Play.

1. On your device, tap **Google Play Store**.
2. Find and install the **Google Classroom** app.

iPhone and iPad

To use Classroom on your iPhone® or iPad®, download the Classroom app from the App Store.

1. On your device, tap **App Store**.
2. Find and install the **Google Classroom** app.

Chrome OS

The Classroom app for Chrome OS works like a bookmark to the web version of Classroom. You can [download it from the Chrome Web Store](#).

Starting in 2020, we won't provide support for Chrome Apps, according to the following schedule. These timelines are only for Chrome Apps, and don't impact Chrome Extensions.



Taking a photo separately and then uploading using a laptop.

Before doing Steps 1 to 4, you need to have taken a photo of your work and uploaded it on to the computer you're using for your Goggle classroom.

1. Go to 'Classwork'
2. Click on the assignment, e.g. 'Maths Summer term Week 1...'
3. Then click on '+ Add or create' ...



4. ... a drop down menu will appear – the third one down is 'file', click that and then upload your photo.
