## **Spellings**

(keep practising the Year 3&4 ones if you need to)

Each week, we are going to focus on words that fit the spelling patterns we're doing in class, any ones we are repeatedly getting incorrect in our writing, and spellings from the statutory spelling list.

The best way to learn them is to focus on five spellings and practise those, then when you have got those add in a couple more. When you have got those as well, stop doing the original five and add in a couple more and keep going like that. But, every week or so test yourself on the previous ones – can you still remember them? If you can, carry on; if not just pop them back in again.

To support this, we will set five new spellings each week to be tested in class every **Friday**.
