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## CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER FOR YEAR 1 - Autumn 1 2018

Our topic for this half term is 'This is Me'. It will give the children great apportunities to find out about themselves and others around them. The class will learn about their bodies, their histories and their place in the world. The different areas of the curriculum will be taught through this topic. We will begin by thinking about what makes us unique and sharing our interests and hobbies. There will be a focus on the five different senses as well as looking more closely at our bodies, labelling the different parts and finding out what they do.

We have transformed our role play area into a hospital complete with a patient's bed, staff uniforms, a reception desk and doctor's kit to treat the patients. The children will encouraged to use the vocabulary introduced to them and to role-play different scenarios which will be introduced in class.
