

Impact of PE premium funding

Quality of PE

All teaching staff have had a least one session with Mr Davis the PE specialist from PHGS. As a result all staff are now aware of the structure of a good PE lesson and how to build on skill development through to whole game contexts.

NEXT STEP – during the sessions with MR Davis this academic year staff to team teach towards the end of the unit to allow MR Davis to observe and help improve teachers skills

Equipment

School has use some of the funding to update Sports equipment and purchase new equipment to allow the staff to deliver a wider range of skills and games. A substantial commitment has also been made to purchase iPads for all classes to use in demonstrating skills and for the children to use during sessions to evaluate their own learning.

Competitions

Through our partnership with Leeds Active Schools we have access to a wide range of inter school competitions and events. We took part in more competitions last academic year than previous years and the target is to enter more events this year.

NEXT STEP – enter more events – including KS1 pupils

Training

Through Leeds Active Schools we are entitled to access training for staff. The curriculum leader has accessed some training and is going to prepare a skills audit for staff and try and match training to individual needs.

NEXT STEP – carry out the skills audit and match training opportunities
