Topic: The Seaside

Welcome to Year 2!

We hope that this letter will ensure a smooth transition into Year Two and help familiarise you with some of the routines and work that your child will be participating in.

Subject:	Class work:	How you can help:
English	<u>Class Books</u> Dougal the Deep Sea Diver. The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch.	Spellings - We will send home a list of spellings each Monday. These spellings are taken from the Year 1 and 2 Statutory Spelling Lists and it is vital that children are not only learning the spelling but also a simple definition for each to increase their understanding. Please encourage your child to learn them as they will be tested every Monday. In class we will be learning a number of techniques to practise spellings and we hope the children will be able to share these with you at home.
English	In Year 2 our significant author is Anthony Browne. We will be researching into his life and looking at what inspired him to become an author.	To find out more about Anthony Browne and some of his books visit this website http://www.anthonybrownebooks.com
Mathematics	Place value, ordering, partitioning and counting. 4 operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division)	You could help at home by: Counting in different steps such as twos, fives, tens, threes and fours. Practising mental addition and subtraction methods. Rapid recall of the 2x, 5x and table and division facts Applying the four operations in a real life context such as finding totals of money and amounts and giving change.
Science	Our topics are 'Uses of everyday materials'. The children will be exploring why a material is used for a particular purpose and how materials can change when we they are manipulated in different ways.	It would help if the children can name different materials such as fabric, paper, plastic, wood and metal. Visit the library for books or research on the internet, BBC schools has a great science section.
Topic	We begin the year with an exciting topic called Oh I do Like to be Beside the Seaside! The children will explore the local area and compare it to different coastlines. They will be using a range of resources, geographical skills and looking at what it was like to visit the seaside in the past. We will be finding out about the uses of Lighthouses and our Art and DT will link with this topic also!	It would help if the children could name some seaside and costal towns in Britain. Encourage the children to find these towns and resorts on a map.

Specific dates and home learning	<p>P.E. - Tuesday and Thursday - please make sure that your child has a full, named PE kit in school for every day because of changeable weather.</p> <p>Learning Log- Set Monday, in for Monday. A sheet will be sent home each week.</p> <p>Spellings- Set Monday, tested following Monday</p>
Targets for children	<p>Read daily at home and at school.</p> <p>Help your child learn their times tables and spellings.</p>
