## Dear Parent/Carer

All Reception children will be part of just one 'Bubble' as less than 15 children are returning this term. As one group they will access two rooms for different learning but will mix with all the children in the 'bubble' across the week.

However, to ensure a smooth drop off and pick up we have allocated children to two groups with staggered pick up and drop off times. Your child has been allocated to **Reception group B.** The staff members for the 'Bubble' will be Mrs Matthews/Mrs Manderville, Ms Etherton, Mrs Rockcliff and Mrs Rumsey for lunch cover.

For this group your entry gate will be through the **top gate on the front playground.** You will then walk through the gate to the corner of the Year 4 class area where you will wait at the cone and drop your child off with the teacher as they are ready. If there is a queue please stand 2m distances from other families next to the spaced cones. When you have dropped off your child with the class teacher please circle away from other waiting families and depart through the KS1 playground to the gate where you entered.

Your child will be collected by a member of staff who will take the children one at a time inside to wash hands.

Your child's drop off time is **9.15 am** and you will need to pick your child up at **3.15pm**.

Please send your child with a full water bottle and packed lunch if they are not having school meals. Your child will also need snacks for break times as there will be no tuck shop.

Please order a school lunch if you wish by emailing the school office as soon as possible.

Please ensure your child has freshly laundered clothes on each day, these can either be school uniform or other school appropriate garments.

Please ensure your child has washed their hands before leaving home and has a supply of tissues in their pocket/bag in order to catch and bin any coughs or sneezes.

We are looking forward to welcoming your child/ren back to school.
